- 3. Review and Approve Feb 2021 Meeting Minutes
 - Meeting called to order 6:31pm

- 4. Dpac Representative
 - Welcome Lakhbir, President of DPAC
 - Jordan Tinny stated no fundraisers this school year
 - There are no grad/dry grad fundraisers
 - It is a short time to collect funds for a playground, it is difficult but if any fundraisers are happening please be very sure to ensure all COVID-19 protocols are being followed
 - How is PAC expected to raise playground funds when there are no fundraisers yes it is really difficult but if there is any fundraisers happening just ensure to be COVID-19 safe. Principals were notified of no fundraisers
 - Marle mentioned she did have a conversation with Shelly, and it was ok to take on a very minimal number of fundraisers
 - Playground extension request was sent in the fall; however, the playground committee didn't want an extension
 - What if the school PAC can't put together the funds school district will remove portions of the playground they deem unsafe

- Playground can be replaced in phases vs all at once
- Apply for all the grants!
- In response to advise from the DPAC representative, it was proposed that PAC no longer transfer money from the PAC account into the district Sullivan playground account unless needed at the fundraising deadline. The DPAC representative explained that if we were to raise over the amount needed by donors, any money from the PAC account that had been transferred to the district account would not be reimbursed. It would be held for the next playground, whenever that would be. This was her experience after raising funds for her school playground
- We were advised to instead designate portions the PAC would put towards the playground clearly in the budget notes but not transfer the money until/unless needed at the fundraising deadline
- A vote was proposed by Harjeet for all those in favor of designating PAC funds to be contributed towards the playground and to not transfer any further money to the district playground account until the fundraising deadline
- The voting results were all in favor to not transfer any further money to the district playground account until the fundraising deadline

5. Crossing Guard

- Crossing guard requests are put through the school district
- Marle will send City Counsellors a letter to request for a crossing guard

6. Treasurer Report

- Gaming Account: \$5000 cheque for playground has cleared
- ALL PAC Account outstanding cheques have cleared
- Playground Account: balance is as of March 8 \$35,813.58 (numbers from Rosie)
- Sindy will add a budget line to the PAC funds given towards playground earmark but don't send funds to district account yet
- Shelly did mention there was a lack of technology in the school, there is a focus on the playground and after that the school could you use more laptops
- Will the district give additional technology if the numbers of students grow in the school there will be an increase in the budget but not sure how much
- How up to date is the technology at the school smart boards are outdated, even though one class was supposed to go back up on the wall but because the school has a case of asbestos the district will not let that happen
- There is a buy back option for technology the district takes end of life tech and replaces it with
- Shelly will look into a possibility to have the smart boards put back up in the classrooms
- The district considers the smart boards old and the newer tech is projectors
