9. Principle Update

- 1. **Registration** We have 33 Kindergarten students registered for next year so far. Getting very close to 2 full time K classes.
- 2. **Construction** Continuing on the lane and sidewalk beside the school and moving to the back parking lot now. Outside stairs on the north side are being built. On track for project completion end of June at this point.
- 3. **5 New Computers** arrived and are in use by students. Thank you to the PAC for the generous contribution towards these computers. Students and teachers are very appreciative of the new technology!
- 4. The Easter Hunt was a huge success. Students and teachers all enjoyed the experience and we all appreciate the time and effort of those involved. Thank you!
- 5. Staffing We are hosting a student EA for practicum in May.
 - New IST teacher, Tia Dawson, starts this Friday, one day a week.
 - Ms. Villette, LST, is one leave until the end of April. Position is being posted.
- 6. Health and Safety Change in mask policy as per Provincial Health Authority.
 - No face-to-face meetings unless absolutely necessary
 - No visiting parents or district staff
 - Avoid use of playground after school. Encourage students to go straight home.
 - Monthly H&S meetings for full staff.
 - Max social distancing wherever possible
 - Staggered recess and lunch breaks have been in place since Sept.
 - Further changes will be made as necessary, based on the needs of the school, in a tiered approach.
