AGENDA/MINUTES:

- 1. Adoption of previous minutes: General meeting on October 20, 2021.
 - a. Tables Costco deal 21 tables for \$3000 Rachel to check not urgent until spring
 - b. Grade 7 initiatives to be noted as a topic on their own instead of being under Playground fundraisers.

2. Financial Update (Sindy S): Complete accountings attached

- a. Current Balance
- b. Slotted for next batch of deposits for beginning to mid Dec.
- c. Late confirmation from Rosie for Playground \$49,653.72
- d. Scratch cards fundraiser \$7036.43 biggest deposit
- e. Hot Lunches Last year was more than usual \$1100 usually around \$800 so slightly less but will catchup in Spring.
- f. Pizza cheques cleared made \$344.11

3. Principal's Update (Rachel D)

- a. School Tours available to all parents Scheduled for Wed, Thu and Fri (24-26 Dec 2021) at 3:30pm
 - i. 10-15 parents have booked for each day
 - ii. Limited to 20 people

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- b. Children's Term 1 Reports Dec 7th due to go home
 - i. Most teachers have switched from FreshGrade app to Paper reports this year
 - ii. Ms. Hansen is the only class is using FreshGrade for assessment
 - iii. Some classes still using Freshgrade to share student work but not reports.
 - iv. Parents will receive reports in Dec, Mar and June.
 - v. Plus two interim reports in Oct and May.

<u>Call for action from PAC:</u> Currently None. FYI only.

- c. **Bookings for Parent Teacher interviews** (Dec 14) will be conducted via Office App, Microsoft Bookings this time. Benefits of doing that are –
 - i. Teacher's availability is visible to parents and goes right into their calendars
 - ii. Will go live on Nov 30th
 - iii. Teachers will choose which format they feel comfortable with- some will be on Teams, some will be in person.
 - iv. If in person, parents will have to wait outside and be brought in by the teacher as they will need to clean the desk and sanitise between meetings etc.

- d. Grade 6/7 Immunizations scheduled for Dec 8
 - i. Hepatitis and HPV These are regular grade 6 and catch up for grade 7
 - ii. Helpers needed for snack and juice? Yes
 - iii. Location in the gym if need to be private them can go in the stage
 - iv. Purchase of juice and bear claws is less than \$90 so don't need approval

<u>Call for action from PAC</u>: Need 2-3 parents to help \rightarrow Elaine, Harjeet, Stacey have volunteered.

e. Music/Christmas Concert

- i. No Christmas Concert this year
- ii. Music Sing-along 2 afternoon performances in Gym and ask parents to join in virtually.
- iii. Working for primary classes only, no plans for intermediates.
- iv. Ms. Ibbotson will look at doing a K-4/5 showcase of learning in the gym in the spring for her music classes. Parents will be invited to the gym.

Call for action from PAC: Currently None. FYI only.

f. School Growth

- i. Boundary changes Right now district is looking for a small boundary change and moving some kids from Cambridge over to Sullivan next year.
- ii. Other big change we are no longer a closed catchment school. Starting next year. This means we can start taking a waitlist parents need special form from

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their catchment school and then look in Sep 2022 of how many kids we can accommodate.

iii. Expect further growth and Principal Der has no concerns about space at this stage.

iv. Provides introductions of new families to the school which is always great! **Call for action from PAC:** Currently None. FYI only.

g. Playground Grant

- i. PEP (Provincial grant) given every year to provincial school
- ii. Sullivan Elementary is currently #2 on the list \$165k (usually split between top 2 each year)
- iii. One hang up that Ms. Der can foresee now is the Flooding and disaster relief effort required in Abbotsford now. So there is no guarantee whether the provincial government might need to reallocate the funds to the roads and redevelopment efforts etc.
- iv. Scenario #1 If we don't get the grant -
 - 1. Then we may not have enough funds for the new playground next year.
 - 2. PAC and school need to continue fundraising efforts with this assumption
 - 3. Principal Der is asking District if we can get extension to remove playground for another year. Discussions with Director of landscaping expect answer in another week.
- v. Scenario #2 If we do get the grant
 - 1. Street hockey rink or ashball put on gravel etc.. can do tons of things to do for intermediary kids if we get the grant and hit the target.
- vi. Expect to know by March 2022

Call for action from PAC: Currently None. FYI only.

- h. Blue fence around the school Principal Der had a meeting with Dir of landscaping
 - i. Grass is still tender so there's two ways to deal with it either keep blue fencing up till spring or take it out and reseed in spring. So going for option 2 to remove the fence and re-seed.
 - ii. Only area to keep the fencing is near the basketball need to add another drainage for the basketball to avoid kids going through the marshy area.
 - iii. Grass wont look the best but will be able to reseed in the spring.

- b. Also looking to do Home Alone course for 10yr and up in conjunction in Jan

8. Kitchen Academy Overview (Marle P)

- a. Little Kitchen Academy Flagship store is in South Surrey
- b. 2nd Store in Panorama village is opening on Dec 20th
- c. <u>Current Promotion</u>: When a Sullivan student registers, they will flag the school and for every student registration, Kitchen Academy will give \$10 back to school.
- d. Program Overview:
 - i. Montessori style aged 3-18yr old cooking program.
 - ii. Don't work with meats all is plant based and organics, and local sourcing form farms where possible.
 - iii. Good environment for kids to learn how to be healthy
 - iv. 7 stages of knives wooden to metal knives
 - v. Could do fields trips or get kids to the classes
 - vi. 10 kids per class and 3 instructors per class Also allows for kids with helpers
 - vii. Age groups like 3-5, 6-8, 9-12, 13-18 yrs
 - viii. In Dec drop ins will also be welcome. Then camps during holidays 4 day camps.
 - ix. 4 week sessions start in late Jan
 - x. School aged kids come at 4-7pm during school days and smaller kids in day time.

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- e. Principal Der and the schoolteachers will be invited for a walkthrough to have a look and explain to the students once construction is done.
- f. PAC is also invited if they are interested. Can have a walkthrough once open.
