 - a. remaining funds Sports Court \$35,000, request to top up funding
 - currently \$5,557.40 held at the District & \$18,429.06 set aside in PAC account from playground Fundraisers. Westcoast seeds fundraiser money still coming approx \$400 & Return-It Depot has approx \$350.
 - ii. would require a further \$11,013.54 from PAC account to fund Sport Court

Vote: To purchase a sport court, with the request from PAC being for \$35,000 with approx 24,000 already set aside for playground. Making it approx an extra 11,500. All in favour: 9 Against: 0 Vote passed

 - b. all kids can use it, suitable for ages 5-12, the swing would replace one of the current swings, installed by Habitat who is currently doing the playground
